

Rules:

1. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions in preparation of this event. They will not be responsible for any damage, loss or injury whatsoever, which may arise in connection with the Ride. It is a condition of acceptance that every entrant shall indemnify the Organisers and landowners against any claim or damage, loss or injury which results directly or indirectly from any action or negligence on their part. Participants must have adequate third-party insurance.
2. All Riders must wear a hard hat with the harness properly fastened. Hats must meet the minimum current accepted standards. Body protectors to be worn if jumping the XC jumps (ONLY jump those obstacles that are flagged)
3. Take care to keep our venue clean and tidy and pick up droppings and do not muck out lorries/trailers on site.
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times within Ipley Manor and under control in the New Forest.
5. Riders to keep to well defined tracks and paths.
6. Careful passing is allowed.
7. Please be considerate to other participants, forest users and livestock at all times. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave and and banned from future events.
8. Children <16 must be accompanied. Riders on lead reins must start in good time in order to complete the ride.
9. The Organisers reserve the right to adapt the course/exclude fences on the day with regard to ground conditions, marshal availability and other safety considerations.
10. The decision of the Organisers on any matter is final.
11. Online entries are only valid once an email acknowledgement has been received, confirming your entry.
12. Prizes and trophies will be determined by the amount of fundraising presented on the day by 12.30pm.

Directions:

Exit the A326 Totton to Fawley road at the Applemore roundabout onto the New Forest towards Beaulieu Road station. Go straight across the crossroads and Ipley Manor is then about 400m on the right.

The Course:

An approximate 10 mile marked, mapped & marshaled ride across the open Forest + enjoy optional jumps on the Ipley Manor X-Country course.
