Covid-19 Compliance Protocols (summary) – Effective from 10/8/20

- You MUST NOT attend any New Forest Trail Hunting Meet if you, or anyone in your household, has experienced ANY of the symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days or is in quarantine.
- You MUST Maintain strict social distancing in accordance with Government guidelines.
- Field sizes are being limited so if you wish to Trail Hunt you must 1) inform the Secretary by e mail, before midnight two days in advance (eg. Midnight on Saturday for a Tuesday Meet) If space allows, the Secretary will then confirm your place, and which designated car park you may use. ONLY use this car park. All payments need to be made in advance, by Bank transfer.
- Unless advised by the Secretary you will not be able to Hunt.
- All mounted Field and foot followers with a specific task must complete a Track and Trace Contact form available on the NFH web site and hand it to the Secretary every day that they are hunting.
- All Hunters should, wherever possible, travel in a vehicle only with members of their own household.
- In the designated car parks Hunt participants are asked not to socialise outside of their support bubble/household and not share food/drink or equipment with other Hunt participants at any time during the day.
- Do not arrive at the car park unnecessarily early and once returning to your vehicle, load and leave promptly.
- All vehicles should have a supply of hand sanitizer.
- For the time being there will be no Lawn Meets and the 'meet' will be a venue merely to bring all mounted Hunt participants together from the various designated car parks to start the day. This will be a point to assemble only, before moving off.
- Mounted participants MUST FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE FIELD MASTER AT ALL TIMES.
- All mounted participants should carry a small hand sanitizer and face mask.
- Any mounted Hunt participant under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult at all times.
- Accidents: Only essential persons should assist, face coverings should be worn and hand sanitizer used when undertaking treatment. Contact should be minimised.
- If, post the Hunt Day, Covid-19 symptoms develop, and it is confirmed with a positive test you MUST inform the Secretary as soon as possible so that the necessary actions are taken.
- Foot followers, other than those with a specific task on the day, should avoid using designated car parks until after the mounted field have left. And then only if social distancing can be maintained.
- Behave with courtesy, respect and good manners towards members of the public, esp. with regards to social distancing
- A Covid-19 Officer will be appointed each Hunt Day to ensure these protocols are adhered to.
