

## THE NEW FOREST HOUNDS CHARITY FLAT RACE - KINDLY SPONSORED BY LANDFORD ESTATES

### SCHEDULE OF CONDITIONS AND ENTRY FORM

To be run at Larkhill on Sunday March 17<sup>th</sup> 2019 time TBC (before the start of the point to point racing)

Races can be hazardous events and all competitors enter entirely at their own risk. The New Forest Hounds can take no responsibility for any injury or accident to any person competing or otherwise who attend this event. It is a condition of entry that all competitors carefully read and signify acceptance of the risks and rules as set out in the schedule below:-

1. Over a distance of approx 1 ½ miles on the flat. Mementos to all riders. This race is held jointly in aid of the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Air Ambulance and Hunt Funds.
2. A race for non-thoroughbreds, also no horse to have been in training under any recognized rules, including Arab Racing. (Passports and Vaccination Records to be present on day of race and be available for inspection). They are to be ridden either by subscribers of the hunt or by people who have paid the minimum of 5 days cap or equivalent this season, as determined by the hunt secretaries. Horse or pony that has won 3 consecutive races will not be eligible to enter. Riders not to hold any category of professional or amateur licence under BHA or PTP authority rules and must be 16 years or over. Weights catchweights. Number bibs to be provided.
3. This race is not run under the rules of the BHA. Numbers will be restricted according to the safety factor set by the Course Inspector. Entries are only accepted at the discretion and invitation of the committee and will be subject to ballot in the event of over-subscription, a waiting list will be held in this event. Competitors are asked to obtain a minimum of £100 sponsorship before entering with Sponsor Monies due on the day of the race before collecting number. Entry Fee £25 which is non-returnable. Entries Close Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Hard Hats to BSEN 1384 or PAS015 standard must be worn. Body Protectors to Level 3 are strongly recommended for all competitors. Whips may be carried, but not used. No spurs. Please state the colours you will be racing in. No need for fancy silks anything bright will be fine.
4. All competitors are reminded that they are responsible for their own actions and those of their animals, in particular they must ensure that they and their horses are fit to race on the day and that they hold adequate third party liability insurance. Riders are not covered under the Point to Point Riders Qualification Certificate Insurance Scheme.
